(How to pay the fee will be notified after registration form is sent to the secretariat.) (The registration fee will cover registration, conference materials, 2 receptions) (Lunch may not be included in the registration fee.)

Conference Site:

The conference will take place at Liszt Ferenc Conference Centre in Sopron, one hour away from Wien by bus or train. Sopron is closer to Wien, Austria than to Budapest, Hungary. The way to the conference site will be informed after registration. Sopron is Hungary's westernmost city and the only one in the country with a virtually intact medieval nucleus. It is a city with wonderful wine, beer, music and dancing.

Accommodation: Most participants shall stay at Best Western Pannonia hotel (<http://www.pannoniahotel.com/e1.htm>) and Sopron hotel (<http://www.hotelsopron.hu/magyar/>). Both are 4 star hotels and very comfortable. IPRA delegates shall stay at the hotels at a discounted price. We will negotiate with the hotels for the lower price. The price of single room shall be \$30-\$50 per person per night. You shall receive more information after you register.

Scholarship:

A) Those from the South can apply for the travel grant. 1) Applicants should send the paper proposals, at least resume of the paper to both IPRA secretariat and the commission convener. 2) Please send application form to IPRA secretariat 3) The grant scales are A) \$1,000, B) \$1,500, C) \$2,000, D) \$2,500, E) \$3,000. The scholarship shall be allocated with consideration of involvement in IPRA activities, paper presentation, geographical representation, and budget.

B) Graduate students as well as young researchers without stable position can apply for exemption of registration fee. 1) Applicants should send the paper proposals, at least resume of the paper to both IPRA secretariat and the commission convener. 2) Please send application form to IPRA secretariat.
